

Stony Hill Family,

Beginning Sunday, September 20, we will hold two services on Sunday mornings. We intend for this to be a temporary arrangement in the life of our church.

Two options:

- **8:30am – Face Covering Required Service** – indoors in the main meeting room in the FLC
- **10:00am – Face Covering Optional Service** – outdoors on the lawn
  - Note: this service will move indoors soon. We are only continuing to hold it outdoors because many who attend this service prefer the nice weather. We will transition this service indoors once weather is less suitable for an outdoor service.

Guidelines for indoor services:

- Please do not attend if you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Children must **stay with their parents at all times**.
- As you enter the building please maintain social distancing.
- We will not have coffee or bulletins.
- Classrooms and water fountains will be closed.
- Restrooms will be available for URGENT needs only.
- There will be an offering box located at the entrance and exit of the Meeting Room.
- As you leave the service please continue to maintain social distancing.
- **For the 8:30 (face covering only) service:** all in attendance must wear a face covering at all times<sup>1</sup> when in the building (except for music leader and pastor when on stage). In addition, we are asking that all practice social distancing (minimum of 6 feet) with those outside your immediate family.
- **For the 10:00 (face covering optional) service:** all in attendance must practice social distancing (minimum six feet) with those outside your immediate family. There is enough room to maintain that distance both outdoors and in the main meeting room of the FLC. This will keep us in compliance with the most recently published guidelines from the NC Department of Health and Human Services: “People must wear face coverings when in public places, indoor or outdoor, where physical distancing of six (6) feet from other people who are not members of the same household or residence is not possible.”<sup>2</sup> Folks are still encouraged to bring their own lawn chair for the outdoor service. Once we move indoors, space will be available to use your lawn chair indoors if you prefer.
